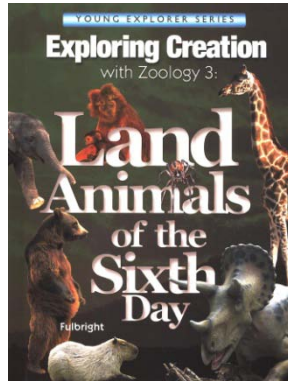

Exploring Creation with Zoology 3: Land Animals of the Sixth Day



3rd – 6th Grades

Class Description: This class will be taught as a **co-op class**. This means that each mom, that has one or more children participating in this class, will be responsible for teaching one or more chapters of the course book. The number of classes each mom will be responsible for depends on the number of families that participate. One chapter will be covered per class. The chapters should be read at home prior to the corresponding class time. The class time is used for review, activities and experiments.

Class Time & Location: These classes will meet approximately every other **Monday** from **10:40 am to 11:45 am**. We will meet at the First Baptist Church. We will have **two classes running on opposite Mondays**. The **first class** will be for **3rd & 4th graders** and that class will begin on **Monday, September 14th**. The **second class** will be for **5th & 6th graders** and it will begin on **Monday, September 21st**.

Class Fees: Since this is a co-op class, there is no monthly fee. However, there is **\$25 book fee**. Julie sold all the books previously purchased at the August Support Meeting. However, after registration is complete, she will make one more group order for those of you still needing a book.
